TO PRECLUDE POSSIBLE ENGINE INGESTION OF INDUCTION AIR FILTER MATERIAL, DISCARD THE EXISTING "POLYURETHANE TYPE" AIR FILTER AND REPLACE WITH A PAPER AIR FILTER AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. REMOVE LOWER COWL, OPEN FILTER ACCESS DOOR, REMOVE AND DISCARD EXISTING AIR FILTER AND SCREEN.
- 2. INSPECT AIRBOX/FILTER HOUSING AND CARBURETOR INLET FOR PIECES OF THE POLYURETHANE AIR FILTER THAT MAY HAVE BECOME SEPARATED. VACUUM HOUSING TO REMOVE ANY FOREIGN OR LOOSE MATERIAL.
- 3. LOCALLY PURCHASE FRAM AIR FILTER PART NUMBER CA146PL OR AC AIR FILTER PART NUMBER A134C FROM AUTOMOTIVE SUPPLY AND INSTALL IN AIRBOX/FILTER HOUSING. INSURE THAT FILTER IS CENTERED AND REASSEMBLE FILTER ACCESS DOOR AND LOWER COWL.
- 4. IMMEDIATELY TELEPHONE OR TELEX GRUMMAN AMERICAN SERVICE DEPARTMENT (CLEVELAND) AFTER COMPLIANCE WITH THIS BULLETIN. CONFIRM TELEPHONE CALLS VIA WRITTEN CONFIRMATION.
- 5. SUBMIT WARRANTY CLAIM FORM NUMBER GAA-740 FOR PARTS AND LABOR CREDIT.
