TIME OF COMPLIANCE:

GENERAL

The Collins AMR-350 Audio/Marker Panel has been optionally installed on many Gulfstream American AA-5A and AA-5B aircraft. The marker receiver has been interfering with the TDR-950 transponders in installations in which the marker beacon and transponder antennas are in close proximity to one another. Symptoms of this situation are decreased transponder range, or, in some extreme cases, complete suppression of the transponder. Interference may sometimes be observed only when the marker receiver is in the HIGH sensitivity mode.

Affected AMR-350 Audio/Marker Panels are to be reworked in accordance with the attached Rockwell-Collins Service Bulletin No. 5.
