## **GENERAL:**

We have received reports that there has been some confusion concerning the outboard aileron bearing support brackets. The aileron bearing support assembly as shown in the AA-5 Series Illustrated Parts Catalog is P/N 902010-501. This bearing bracket assembly underwent an engineering change dated 5-12-78 and was issued a new part number, 902010-504. This change was not reflected in the latest revision of the AA-5 Series Illustrated Parts Catalog or the AA-5 Series Maintenance Manual dated June 1, 1983. Both parts are considered to be serviceable, however, when replacement of the outboard aileron bearing bracket assembly is necessary, the -504 assembly with the collar on the inboard side should be installed and shimmed as required to obtain the specified aileron end play.
